in her petition for a Writ of Amparo. No to peace talks

THE MORE than 20 years of peace negotiations achieved nothing. From the time when then President Corazon Aquino took the reins of governance and released Maoist messiah Jose Ma. Sison and company, to include Satur Ocampo, and until today, nothing positive was achieved except that the government was pushed to the wall with calculated lies and deception by the Maoist communist leaders.

Montevista barangay tanod united for peace and order

THE LOCAL Government Unit of Montevista in cooperation with 3rd Special Forces (Arrowhead) Battalion and the Compostella Valley Provincial Police Office (CVPPPO) assembled all the village security forces of Montevista and organize them into the “Montevista Municipal Security Force” last July 15, 2009 at the Municipal Gym of Montevista, CVP.

About 192 members of Barangay Police Laban sa Krimen (BPLK) Tanods, from the 20 barangays of the said municipality, brought along 96 assorted firearms and attended the Recognition Program and Seminar aimed to equip the members with basic skills and knowledge needed to maintain and uphold peace and order in their areas as well as to strengthen links among the members.

The members of the “Montevista Municipal Security Force” were formally presented to Mayor Teopista T. Jauod, the police and military authorities where they were recognized as augmentation forces that can help protect their communities.

Mayor Jauod said, “this program was conceptualized purposely to prevent the recovery efforts of the NPA, to minimize the activities of lawless elements, and to attract development in the area.” “Likewise, this enables the local Police to account the existing members of Brgy Tanods that can protect the villages against lawless elements,” the Mayor added.

PSI Julius A Borja, the Chief of Police of Montevista said, “This activity will show to the public and would be-investors that the threat of the NPA in the municipality of Montevista is already negligible. Likewise, only few lawless groups are left in the area and this can be easily countered by the area security system.”

Also present during the said activity were the Commanders of 3SFBn and 25IB, Lt Colonels Roylan Orquia and Gilbert Saret, respectively. They both agreed that the initiative also shows that the people of Montevista wanted peace and are united to defend their town.

The untold story of Ka Sitoy

IT WAS a cloudy Friday morning on 19 November 2008 when we left from Camp Panacan to Barangay Caso-on, ComVal Province to witness the exhumation of the remains of Arnel Visagas or Ka Sitoy, a member under Maoist communist-terrorist's Guerilla Front 3. Ka Sitoy was among those encountered by the troops of 3rd Special Forces Battalion led by 1Lt. Vicente Cammayo last November 7, 2008. That ill fated encounter resulted to the death of three (3) soldiers and the capture of 1Lt. Cammayo by the communist-terrorists

Upon arrival at the detachment in Barangay Casoon, I wandered around. I noticed the PNP-SOCO, media, barangay residents and the immediate family of Ka Sitoy were waiting by the vicinity. Maj. Roylan Orquia, commander of 3SFBn informed everyone that we will be traveling towards Sitio Anagasi on board M35 truck, Kennedy Jeep and other military and police vehicles. I drew closer to Ka Sitoy's mother, Mrs. Visagas, whom I boarded with in the same vehicle.

Rain started, as we were traversed the

muddy road to Sitio Aganasi.

Mrs Visagas started talking nonchalantly in response to the questions asked about her son's childhood and membership in the CPP/NPA/NDF. Concealing her aches and pains, Mrs. Visagas stood firm for her son answering every question asked. As once a child myself, I see the agony of a mother, the heartaches and worries caused by her prodigal son.

Mrs. Visagas tells the story of her son as she recalls. "Arnel was with the NPA for 12 years. All of my children were recruited by the communist-terrorist NPA but Dodoy (Arnel) was the only one who was convinced and eventually joined," she exclaimed. According to Mrs. Visagas, Arnel was a silent person whose daily routine revolved around the farm and at home. She continues to share, "He was a very good son but he was slow-learner compared to his other siblings"

Momentarily, our conversation was cut as we needed to get off the vehicle which got stuck in mud. While the driver and escorts manually turned the front wheel drive for us to get through,

Mrs. Visagas kept to herself. Returning back to the vehicle, Mrs. Visagas, whose thoughts were lucid, continues the story of Arnel. "My husband called me up to inform me that Arnel died in an encounter with the soldiers. I was in Manila working as a household helper since 2004. I can hardly believe it, I said to my husband *"its impossible!!! Arnel just called me a week ago."*

Mrs. Visagas reveals that in the past months, Arnel has been calling her to find him a job in Manila. He had been telling his mother that he was tired and wanted to rest. "I told him that I will ask my boss if he could accommodate my son in one of their family businesses." Hearing that, I retorted, *"Nay, indeed, he rested in peace!"* I overheard one of our escorts behind said, *"It was already the sign, Nay, he rested for good. Maybe he is really tired of what he went through."*

Mrs Visagas explains that it was his husband who insisted to exhume Arnel's remains. She has been to the graveyard when she arrived from Manila. In grief, she nagged at Arnel's graveyard while tapping her hands on the ground saying, *"Look at you, you were buried just like a dog because you won't listen to me!"*

Approaching Sitio Anagasi, we crossed over a small river, and halted to disembark. I thought, we have arrived, but alas, we started on foot to proceed to the sitio. As we walked, Mrs Visagas held a small bag and an umbrella. I looked around... ahead of us and behind us. I saw media friends, the SOCO and local residents who brought with them shovels, sacks and jungle knives walking.


Their only message is to say – “We are still around”, but never would they admit that they are on the way towards extermination!

Openly the hurting mother said to me, *“If not for my husband’s request, I won’t go back here. “Dodoy” can’t blame me for this. He’s hard headed! He won’t listen to me anymore. I told him I never dreamed of having a NPA son. Our neighbors tell me that he has a big position in the said organization. I told them, “I don’t care. Where did the Php 10M come from?

NOT ONLY were millions of pesos involved but many believed that the influence and power appurtenant to being members of the country's legislature has come into play during the Maoist communist inspired anti-PGMA protest actions last July 27, not only in Metro Manila but in some key cities throughout the country.

The ALLIANCE FOR NATIONALISM AND DEMOCRACY (ANAD) Partylist could only muster exasperation when the protestors came out with blaring sound systems loaded on trucks and other vehicles, with tarpaulins replacing placards and other signages, and effigies of gigantic sizes. To top it all, during meal time, food packs were distributed to thousands of protestors by arranged catering services.

"This must be investigated by Congress and other agencies of government, like the COA, to ferret out the truth on the sourcing of their funds," Alcover said even as he slammed Maoist communist sectoral front and pseudo partylist organizations to disclose their sources of funds.

"We will know then how much are they receiving from foreign sources, from extortion within the country, and the probable use of government funds," he said. *(Myrna Atadi)*

2 civilians killed, 1 wounded in Davao

PANACAN, DAVAO CITY – Two innocent civilian became the new victims of the Maoist communist NPA when 10 NPA rebels, under Guerilla Front 54, waylaid them at the intersection of Lumundao, Barangay Marilog, Marilog District, Davao City at about 9am, July 23.

The victim, identified as Canoto Lumbayon, a former Barangay Chairman of Salaysay, Marilog District, sustained gunshot wounds.

Lumbayon was on his way home from Calinan, on-board a motorcycle, together with Celso Agumay, a CAFGU Active Auxiliary (CAA) and Ernesto Sauyan, a member of the Civilian Volunteer Organization (CVO) of Salaysay when NPA rebels simultaneously fired at them.

Also, CAA Agumay who was unarmed sustained fatal wounds causing his instantaneous death. Agumay reportedly was off-duty and on his way home to attend to the needs of his family. On the other hand, Sauyan, was wounded and was brought to the Davao Medical Center for treatment.

Last July 22 at 10:30am, communist-terrorists NPA murdered Juan Bacharo, a Purok Leader of Barangay Banlag in Monkayo Compostella Valley and two unarmed soldiers who were facilitating the delivery of development projects in the said barangay.

At 1:30pm of the same day, about seven NPA bandits, under Sentro de Grabidad (SDG), Guerilla Front 20 (GF), burned a 10-wheeler truck at Sitio Mahu, Barangay Aragon, Cateel, Davao Oriental. The truck, owned by Maverick Construction, was flagged down while delivering supplies to development projects in the area. The construction company reportedly received threats and extortion demands but refused to give in.

Major General Reynaldo B Mapagu, Commander of 10th Infantry Division, vehemently condemned the recent atrocities perpetrated by NPA, "It is clear enough that these criminals are anti-people and anti-development. Treacherous attacks are what they can easily do now because they cannot face the reality that they have already lost their mass base support."

"Just like Evelyn Pitao, the sister of a well-known NPA leader in the region, they easily killed these innocent people who are public servants, law-abiding citizens and who desire to live a peaceful life in a more improved environment. These bandits are the ones who repeatedly abuse the basic rights of the people," Mapagu added. *(DPAO, IOID, PA)* ☐

"It is high time that the true and real intentions if these people must be revealed. CPP-NPA fighting over money !

CAMP PANACAN, DAVAO CITY- The killing of Evelyn Pitao, last May 23 in Sto. Tomas, Davao del Norte, is an indication of a serious rift among key leaders in the Communist Party of the Philippines/New People's Army (CPP/NPA), a reliable source said.

The main issue has something to do with funds bungled and unremitted by some leaders.

During the first quarter, two members of the Maoist CPP-NPA-NDF'S Central Committee were sent to Mindanao, upon orders of Jose Maria Sison, to check on the unaccounted funds amounting to some Php70 million pesos which forms part of the collections generated through extortion by the CPP/NPA in the Davao Region.

"Leoncio Pitao has become a headache to the CPP. The CPP is frustrated because he has violated party rules and has not implemented the programs of the party in his area. The recent admission of the Medardo Arce Command for the murder of Evelyn Pitao is proof of the ongoing infighting and frustration with him by the CPP/NPA," said Major General Reynaldo Mapagu, commanding general of the 10ID, PA based here.

The Maoist CPP-NPA-NDF'S Southern Mindanao Regional Party Committee (SMRPC) reportedly generates an estimated P 20 million every quarter in Davao region alone. Of this amount, 9.1M comes from logging concessions, 1.6M from mining companies, 3.1M from agri-business, 2.3M from commercial establishments, 0.3M from construction companies, and 2.1M from other sources.

"If we look into the quarterly CPP/NPA fund generation in Davao Region, the missing P70 million could be their taxes exacted for 3 quarters to 1 year. This is indeed a large amount lost that subsequently crippled their operational activities, thus, a big frustration for the Central Committee," Gen. Mapagu added.

On the other hand, a total of 71 former rebels have surrendered to the authorities, since January, 2009, citing demoralization within their ranks due to the misuse and mismanagement of funds by their leaders.

Last March, NPA surrenderees in Compostela Valley revealed that former leaders identified as Ruel Caballes and Catherine Cacdac abandoned their group and took with them party funds.

It was learned that Evelyn Pitao was a sacrificial lamb and murdered by the Maoist CPP-NPA to force her brother to turnover the millions of pesos of funds derived by extortion. (DPAO, 10ID)

On Melissa Roxas' allegation

CHR Chair de Lima's statements are grossly premature and irresponsible.

The following is the official statement on the seeming partiality, lack of objectivity and neutrality exercised by the Commission on Human Rights, through its Chairperson Leila de Lima, on the case of Melissa Roxas as a result of ANAD's press conference held at the Quezon City Memorial Circle last July 25, 2009. - - Rey Salas/ANAD National Spokesman.

THE ALLIANCE FOR NATIONALISM AND DEMOCRACY (ANAD) strongly deplores and is very much saddened by the biased and prejudicial statements issued by Chairperson Leila de Lima of the Commission on Human Rights on the Melissa Roxas case.

The story (pp.2, PDI, July 27) where she was quoted saying, "I wish to stress that the issue before the CHR is the alleged abduction and torture (of Roxas) and not her alleged affiliation. . . ." loudly speaks out of her prejudging the case which at the moment is still subject to several hearings.

Her statement was grossly premature and irresponsible considering the fact that the CHR, being a quasi-judicial body tasked to protect the human rights of all Filipinos and not any select group or individual, is still in the initial stage in determining culpability or otherwise of those named respondents in the complaint.

ANAD strongly maintains our contentions of the following:

- 1. Melissa's affiliation with the NPA is vital as it would greatly bear on credibility, truthfulness, and accuracy of her (Melissa's) Sworn Statement that is now with the CHR.** In her Sworn Statement, Melissa denied her being a member of the Maoist communist-terrorist NPA. However, the material sent by an NPA member in Aurora that I received and read only in July 22, told us otherwise. The video CD that was inserted in the package to support the narrations made in the letter. If one element of her Sworn Statement is found to be falsified or a lie then the entire Sworn Statement, including her allegations of abduction and torture, would be highly questionable and suspect.
- 2. ANAD has never offered conclusions on the materials received, thru LBC, from an NPA member in Aurora Province.** During the press conference last Saturday (July 25), ANAD merely presented the facts of the materials received, showed them to the members of the media, and only made some observations, based on my experience in the Maoist communist CPP-NPA-NDF underground movement.

It would be in the interest of justice and fairness if Chair de Lima would ask Melissa to make her response to the allegations stated in the material we received rather than outright and deliberately setting aside the issue. I challenge the CHR, especially Chair de Lima to have Melissa undergo a Lie-Detector test.

On the other hand, ANAD calls on Renato Reyes, Secretary General of Bayan, not to muddle the issue on Melissa's alleged abduction and torture. However, his statement (pp 2, PDI, 27 July) clearly supports our belief that Melissa was abducted by a special unit of the Maoist communist NPA without her knowing it.

Also, ANAD strongly call on all freedom loving Filipinos to be wary about the present conditions and developments in our country, particularly those initiated by Maoist communist sectoral-front and pseudo partylist organizations. All of these are designed and intended as a propaganda vehicle against the government.
